Description

μClamp® TVS diodes are designed to protect sensitive electronics from damage or latch-up due to ESD. It is designed to replace 0201 size multilayer varistors (MLVs) in portable applications such as cell phones, notebook computers, and other portable electronics. It features large cross-sectional area junctions for conducting high transient currents. This device offers desirable characteristics for board level protection including fast response time, low operating and clamping voltage, and no device degradation.

μClamp®0541Z is in a 2-pin SLP0603P2X3 package. It measures 0.6 x 0.3 mm with a nominal height of only 0.25mm. Leads are finished with lead-free NiAu. Each device will protect one line operating at 5 volts. It gives the designer the flexibility to protect single lines in applications where arrays are not practical. The combination of small size and high ESD surge capability makes them ideal for use in portable applications such as cellular phones, digital cameras, and MP3 players.










Non-Repetitive Peak Pulse Power vs. Pulse Time




Clamping Voltage vs. Peak Pulse Current (tp=8/20 μs)




Junction Capacitance vs. Reverse Voltage




TLP Characteristic

Application Information

Assembly Guidelines

The small size of this device means that some care must be taken during the mounting process to insure reliable solder joints. The figure at the right details Semtech's recommended mounting pattern. Recommended assembly guidelines are shown in Table 1. Note that these are only recommendations and should serve only as a starting point for design since there are many factors that affect the assembly process. Exact manufacturingparameters will require some experimentation to get the desired solder application.

Solder Stencil

Stencil design is one of the key factors which will determine the volume of solder paste which is deposited onto the land pad. The area ratio of the stencil aperture will determine how well the stencil will print. The area ratio takes into account the aperture shape, aperture size, and stencil thickness. A minimum area ratio of 0.66 is preferred for the subject package. The area ratio of a rectangular aperture is given as:

Area Ratio = (L * W) / (2 * (L + W) * T)

Where:

L = Aperture Length

W = Aperture Width

T = Stencil Thickness

Semtech recommends a stencil with square aperture and rounded corners for consistent solder release. The stencil should be laser cut with electropolished finish. A stencil thickness of 0.075mm (0.003") is recommended. A 0.100mm (0.004") stencil may be used, however the stencil opening may need to be increased slightly to achieve the desired area ratio to ensure proper solder coverage on the pad.




Outline Drawing - SLP0603P2X3



Land Pattern - SLP0603P2X3




